Istanbul Full Day Tour

Nov 13 – 14, Saturday & Sunday

- Visit the enchanting Rustem Pasa Mosque, renowned for its use of red Iznik tiles.
- Survey Bible-themed mosaics and frescoes at the Chora Museum, once a Greek Orthodox church.
- Explore the stunning Basilica Cistern and view its barrel-vaulted brick roof, which is supported by over 300 columns.

- Gaze at the breathtaking Great Theater, which seats 24,000 spectators and is still in use.
- Explore the richly ornate Terrace Houses, where the wealthiest residents lived.
- Savor free time to shop for antique jewelry or handmade carpets in alluring Kusadasi.

Naples/Pompeii Full Day Tour

Nov 18, Thursday

- Visit the remarkably well-preserved remains of Pompeii, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- Roam the ancient Roman city's buildings and public spaces, which for centuries were buried under Mount Vesuvius' volcanic ash.
- Examine frescoes, mosaics and everyday Roman artifacts in Pompeii's nearly intact villas.
- Gaze in reverence at plaster casts capturing the final moments of the town's hapless citizens.
- Drive past the resort towns of Sorrento and Castellammare di Stabia, which are set along a stunning coastline.

Barcelona Full Day Tour

Nov 23, Tuesday

Visit The Basilica de la Sagrada Família in Barcelona

- Largely unfinished Roman Catholic minor basilica
 - Construction of the Sagrada Família began under architect Francisco de Paula del Villar in 1882
- Designed by Antoni Gaudi
- UNESCO World Heritage Site
