### DINING RESERVATIONS

We kindly ask guests who made reservations via the Regent Seven Seas Cruises website for Prime 7, Chartreuse or Pacific Rim and did not receive a confirmation card upon embarking today to kindly contact the dining room team or Reception by dialing 0.

Reservations can be made from 12noon - 4pm at the Reservations Desk located on Deck 5.

### MENU PREVIEW

Menus for Compass Rose, La Veranda, Prime 7, Pacific Rim and Chartreuse are available on your suite TV under the Dining Section.

The 24-hour Room Service menu is available in your in-suite Guest Directory, or on your suite TV.

### HEALTH ADVISORY

Regent Seven Seas Cruises strongly encourages guests to practice good hygiene by washing one's hands frequently and thoroughly with soap and warm water. Procedures are in place on board to disinfect and sanitize public areas including door handles, railings and elevator buttons. Guests are also kindly reminded to use the utensils provided in the handling of food at the buffet.

### GENERAL SAFETY BRIEFING

In accordance with International Maritime Law, all guests are required to attend a General Safety Briefing prior to departure from the embarkation port.

**This Safety Briefing will take place at 5:15pm and it is compulsory to attend.**

Guests should use the staircase to reach their Assembly Station. Your assigned Assembly Station is listed on the back of the entrance door of your suite.

*Please note: In the unlikely event of an emergency that requires you to go to your Assembly Station, the following signal will be sounded – seven short blasts followed by one long blast of the ship's alarm system and the ship's whistle.*

### GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

General announcements are audible in the public areas, corridors, and on your television. If you are watching television and the channels suddenly become muted, or if you are in your stateroom and hear an announcement being made in the corridor, simply tune to Channel 2 to hear the announcements. With the exception of our guest safety drill and weekly staff safety drills, announcements are not broadcast inside of suites.

Our Executive Concierge Jeff is located on Deck 5 and may be contacted via Reception. He is available to answer any questions regarding services on board the vessel or ashore, or assist with tracking luggage that may have gone astray during your travels.

### DESTINATIONS SERVICES

The Destination Services Team Roland, Claudia, Joanne, Maria & Yulia are located on Deck 5 next to Reception. They are available to provide you with detailed information on our ports of call. Their services include general port information, shore excursion booking, private arrangements and disembarkation arrangements.

Located in the Atrium on Deck 5 mid-ship, the Cruise Consultant can provide you with information on the Regent Seven Seas Cruises fleet, future cruises and can also assist you in booking a future cruise on board any of the ships of Regent Seven Seas Cruises.

### SMOKING POLICY

For the safety of all guests and staff onboard, we invite you to use Designated Smoking Areas in specific locations throughout the ship, including the Pool Deck (forward starboard side only) and the Connoisseur Club for cigarette and e-cigarette smoking.

- Cigar smoking is permitted in the Designated Smoking Area at the Pool Bar, and within the Connoisseur Club, while pipe smoking is only permitted within the Connoisseur Club.

- All areas other than those specified as Designated Smoking Areas will remain smoke-free. This includes all guest suites and balconies.

Failure to comply with the above smoking policy will result in guests being asked to leave the ship at their expense, without refund or credit for the unused portion of their cruise.

## DAYTIME UNTIL 6PM

Skirts or slacks with blouse or sweater, pant suit or dress for ladies. Slacks and collared shirt for gentlemen. Sport jackets are optional.

### Formal Optional

Guests may opt for a more formal choice of clothing including gowns and cocktail dresses for ladies; dinner jackets or dark suits with tie for gentleman.

On the last night of the voyage, the dress code for dinner is relaxed to allow Guests to be as comfortable as they wish.

When not performing, Philippa enjoys a busy family life at home in Hertfordshire, with her fiancé (classical tenor Nick Allen), and their two small children, Nathaniel and Rose
