DESCRIPTION

Travel around Antigua, taking in the natural beauty and visiting must-see landmarks that showcase the island's history, architecture and culture. Before leaving town, you will stop at the Dow's Hill Interpretation Center to watch a short but enlightening multimedia show and then pause for photos at the blockhouse that served as a lookout for the British in the 18th century. As you might imagine, the views will be spectacular and you may spot musician Eric Clapton's home below. Continuing on, you will pass through traditional villages of West Indies-style chattel houses and smallish plazas that present an authentic view of daily life. More sweeping vistas await you at the Shirley Heights Lookout, Antigua's southernmost point. Nearby, you will find Nelson's Dockyard Village, a fully restored 18th-century naval base where you will enjoy a drink in an historical inn. Afterwards, you will still have time to admire the sleek yachts while meandering around the marina and shops.

DICKENSON BAY BEACH BREAK

DESCRIPTION

Enjoy a relaxing day doing whatever you please at Dickenson Bay Beach, one of the most beautiful stretches of sand on Antigua's northwest coast. It won't take long to reach the beach, which rims a sheltered cove. You might stretch out in the sun, relax in the shade of gently swaying palm tree and stroll along the edge of the beach as the waves lap at the shore. You will enjoy more than three hours basking in the carefree atmosphere, so you won't feel rushed as you while away the time. An Antiguan-style rum punch will be provided and an excellent beachfront restaurant is just a few steps away if you wish to order lunch on your own. When it's time to return to the ship, you should be thoroughly relaxed and refreshed.

ISLAND SAFARI AND BEACH

HIGHLIGHTS

Ride off to the wild southwestern side of the island in a custom-built Jeep® made for off-road adventure. You won't need to travel far beyond St. John's to reach terrain that most vehicles can't even begin to negotiate. On the way to Buckley's Village, you will travel along back roads and make your own roads whenever possible. The landscape will become even more undeveloped in Body Ponds, a rutty watershed full of mud holes and rugged land that is ideal for an exhilarating off-road journey. Be assured that you won't be disturbing the environment, as the driver knows exactly which areas and ecosystems to avoid. You will also drive down Fig Tree Drive as it winds through a rainforest on the way to a pristine beach on the island's southern shore, where you will have time to relax before heading back.

CHAMPAGNE & LOBSTER CATAMARAN CRUISE

HIGHLIGHTS

Sail in a sleek catamaran along Antigua's beautiful west coast to Deep Bay Beach, a well-protected crescent-shaped stretch of sand where you will spend an hour or so relaxing. Along the way, you will pass a number of other idyllic bays and the ruins of Fort Barrington, a stronghold built in the 18th century to protect the approach to St. John's harbor. Upon arriving at the beach, you will be free to swim in the turquoise seas, bask in the sun and stretch out under a palm tree and watch the world go by. The party will begin in earnest on the return cruise, as the champagne will be flowing and succulent grilled lobster will be served for lunch. To enhance the atmosphere, music will be playing in the background, most likely the light-hearted calypso-style music that is wildly popular on Antigua.

SWIM WITH THE STINGRAYS

HIGHLIGHTS

- Swim with southern stingrays in their natural environment.
- Interact with the stingrays and feed them, if you like.
- Ask the stingray wrangler for tips on how best to enhance the experience.
- Learn about stingray behavior that dispels myths about them.

DESCRIPTION

Interact with friendly southern stingrays in their natural environment as they swim around you and even brush up against your body. You will reach the venue Stingray City aboard a small boat and then attend an enlightening orientation on how to make the most of your experience. Once you enter the crystal-clear water, you may swim with the stingrays or simply stand in the shallower areas and interact with these gentle marine creatures. Southern stingrays have flat, diamond-shaped bodies and are typically about 3 to 4 feet across. They often eat shellfish and worms, which they uncover on the sandy ocean floor by waving their "wings." A stingray wrangler will be on hand to offer tips on how best to interact with the stingrays and even feed them.

HISTORICAL ISLAND DRIVE & BEACH BREAK

More sweeping vistas await you at the Shirley Heights Lookout, Antigua's southernmost point. If it is a clear day, you might spot the volcanic island of Montserrat on the horizon. Nearby, you will find Nelson's Dockyard Village, a fully restored 18th-century naval base, where you will enjoy a drink in an historical inn and perhaps browse the museum. A short drive later, you will arrive at Pigeon Point Beach, a lovely stretch of sand where you will spend an hour doing whatever you please. You might swim in the Caribbean, bask in the sun and relax in the shade and gaze out over one of the most idyllic spots on Antigua. While there are no beach chairs or umbrellas available at this public beach, there are naturally shaded areas for those who wish to stay out of the sun. The beach is also equipped with restrooms, changing rooms and freshwater showers.

- Wear a swimsuit under a cover-up and bring a towel if you wish to swim.

With the city lights twinkling on shore and the sun majestically setting at sea, it will be quite the sight in every direction.

A TASTE OF ANTIGUA

As a complement to the tasting, you will dine on dishes that may include conch fritters, jerk chicken, fish fingers and crab cakes, all prepared with local ingredients. WALKING TOUR OF ST JOHN'S

HIGHLIGHTS

- Walk through Antigua's capital, which has preserved its original 17th-century layout.
- Notice the remarkably diverse architecture that goes well beyond West Indian vernacular.

DESCRIPTION

Stroll through downtown St. John's, following a route that the Museum of Antigua and Barbuda has prepared, which ensures that you will see the most historically significant landmarks. The city has retained much of its original layout and is full of magnificent Georgian, Victorian and West Indian vernacular homes. Along the way, the guide will point out architectural features such as lattice work, fretwork patterns and louvered Demerara windows designed to cool the interiors. You can also expect to see the 19th-century Ebenezer Methodist Church and the Cenotaph war memorial that honors soldiers killed in the World Wars. You will also have the opportunity to browse the exhibits in the Museum of Antigua and Barbuda with the curator, who will elaborate on the significance of artifacts ranging from prehistoric pottery and tools to rare hand-carved canoes.

PHOTOGRAPHIC TOUR OF ANTIGUA

HIGHLIGHTS

Another natural wonder awaits you at Long Bay Beach, a lovely stretch of sand rimmed by water so impossibly turquoise that your pictures of it will look as if they have been digitally altered.

Be sure keep looking down on the way to and from Montserrat as whales and sea turtles are often spotted.
