Temple of Kom Ombo

A temple dedicated to Sobek and Horus. One of the most unusual temples of Ancient Egypt, Kom Ombo was mainly built during the Ptolemaic Dynasty from 180-47 BCE.

The temple is unique for its dedication to two different deities: the local crocodile-headed God Sobe - the first 'God of the Kingdom', and the falconheaded God Horus the Elder (also called Haroeris). The double dedication was deliberate. Not only is it architecturally duplicated, with two sets of courts, hyspostyle halls and sanctuaries, the twin temple is symbolic of the local and universalist themes that the two different deities represented.
