





Hats, Gloves & Socks Hat: Fleece hat with a visor and ear flaps is recommended. **Socks:** Extra heavyweight socks made of wool or wool blend. Minimum two pairs. Sock liners: Thin sock liners, worn under your socks for extra warmth. Pack as many liners as you have socks. Neck gaiter: Preferred to scarves for Zodiac travel. Gloves: Windproof and waterproof ski gloves or mitts. Glove liners: Provide extra warmth on cold days. Accessories Mackpack: A water-resistant backpack is provided on board, compliments of Silversea, for carrying items ashore and keeping your arms free for embarking/disembarking the Zodiacs. Waterproof backpack: Recommended if you have a lot of camera equipment. Binoculars: Compact with at least 10X power and 25mm objective diameter for wildlife watching. Trekking poles: Provides a sense of security, increased balance, and confidence when walking on rugged terrain. Seal-proof waterproof bags: To store your electronics. Foot/Hand warmers: For extra warmth. Sunglasses or goggles: U.V. filter protection to cut the glare. Sun and wind protection: Lip balm and waterproof sunscreen (SPF 30 minimum).

IMPORTANT ANTARCTICA GENERAL GUIDELINES

The General Guidelines apply to all visitors and all activities in the Antarctic Treaty area¹. All visits to Antarctica should be conducted in accordance with the Antarctic Treaty, its Protocol on Environmental Protection, and relevant Measures, Decisions and Resolutions adopted at Antarctic Treaty Consultative Meetings (ATCM). All activities must be subject to an Environmental Impact Assessment and must have prior approval/permission or meet all the requirements of the relevant National Competent Authority.

These Guidelines provide general guidance for visiting any location, with the aim of ensuring that visits do not have adverse impacts on the Antarctic environment, including wildlife and ecosystems, or on its scientific, wilderness and aesthetic values. *ATCM Site Guidelines* for Visitors provide additional site-specific advice for some locations. Guidelines concerning particular risks such as aircraft use, or avoiding the introduction of non-native species may also apply.

Consult these Guidelines before you visit Antarctica and plan how to minimize your impact.

If you are part of a guided visitor group, abide by these guidelines, pay attention to your guides, and follow their instructions. If you are the organizer of your own visit or the visit of a group and respective activities, you are responsible for abiding by these guidelines. You are also responsible for identifying the features of the sites you visit that may be vulnerable to visitor impacts, and for complying with any specific requirements related to protected areas, historic sites and monuments, activities or risks. Specific requirements can be included within ATCM Site Guidelines, Antarctic Specially Protected Area (ASPA) and Antarctic Specially Managed Area (ASMA) management plans, or station visit guidelines.

- Can Silversea recommend an anti-nausea medication? My pharmacist said Scopolamine
 patches are no longer available in Canada, which is very disappointing. Other than Gravol, does
 Silversea have any suggestions?
- We can easily see the temp in Santiago (summer yay!) but can you please give us a general range in temp for Antarctica, eg is it 0 to -10, or is it closer to -10 to -20. We'll pack short-sleeve shirts if it will likely be a balmy -10 (we are from Alberta:)

 would be much more useful than using our current backpacks and then bringing
 home two empty ones in our suitcases.
